Public Health Situation Highlights:

- **Highlights during 03-14 Dec 2007 in 9 districts**

Disease	Total Number of Cases
Diarrhoea	3849
ARI/Pneumonia	4858
Skin Disease	8581
Eye Infection	2848
Fever/Typhoid	12353

- Bagerhat district has the highest number of reported cases of Diarrhea, skin diseases, eye infections, pneumonia and fever / suspected typhoid since previous reporting period.
- The trends of Diarrhea and ARI/pneumonia cases are declining and / or static.

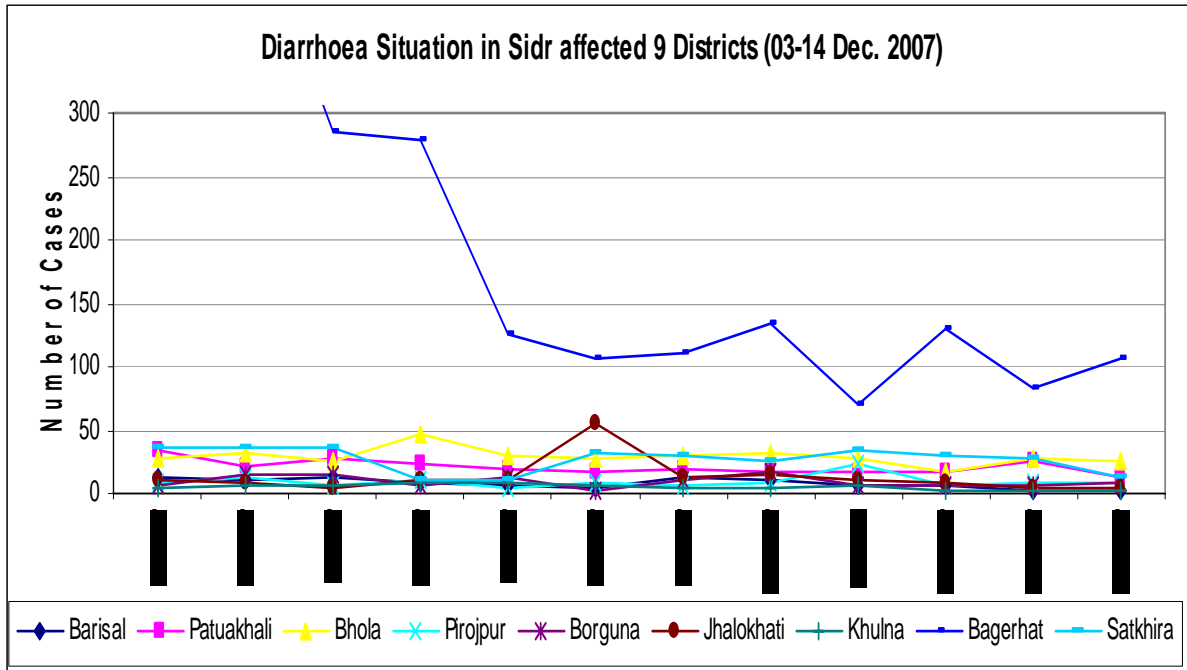
Public Health Interventions:

- The 4 Health Cluster sub groups have held their meetings and finalization of ToRs are underway.
- An *In depth health assessment* methodology is being finalized along with logistic and financial arrangements to get the current status of health services and needs in the SIDR affected 9 districts as requested and in collaboration with Directorate General of Health Services, WHO and partner NGOs.

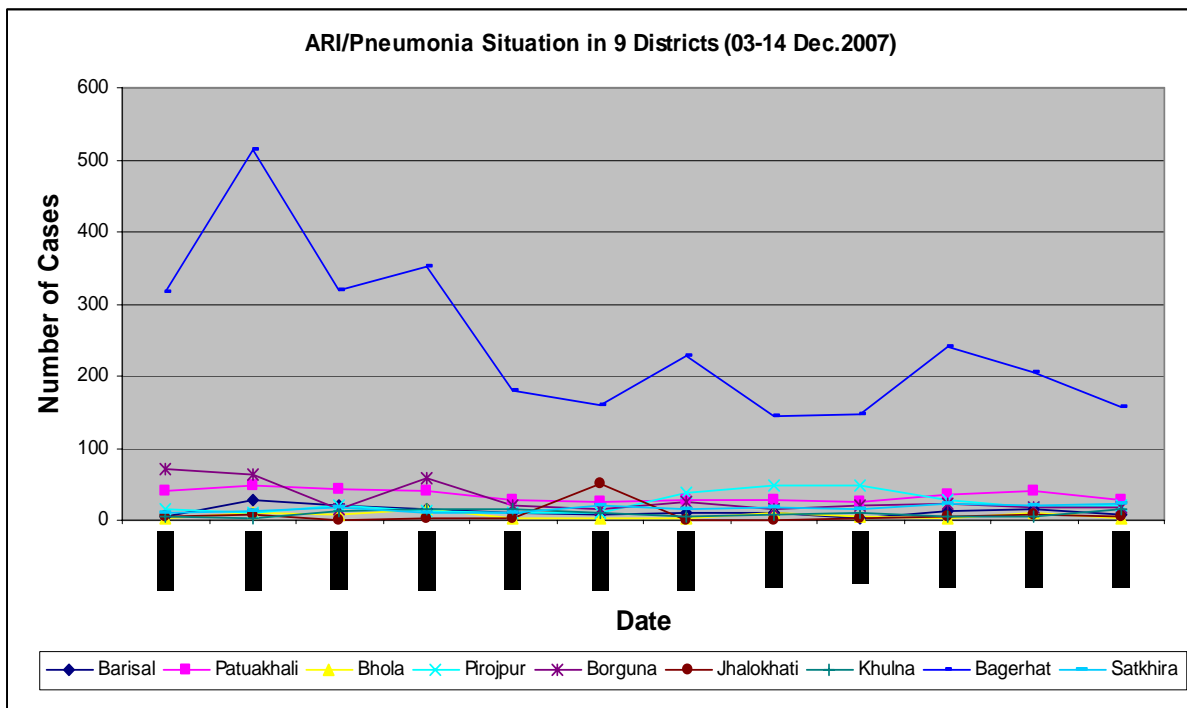
Challenges and Priority Action:

- To identify the priority needs and address the issues in close consultation with Health Cluster Sub Groups and Ministry of Health.
- To assess needs and technical suitability for the establishment of the national Health Disaster Management Institute, WHO Bangladesh needs technical advice and support from Regional Office and Head Quarter.
- To strengthen timely collection of data about cases and deaths, reports from all groups (reproductive health, nutritional status, psychosocial & mental health) must be submitted on a regular basis, particularly age and sex specific data from the field.

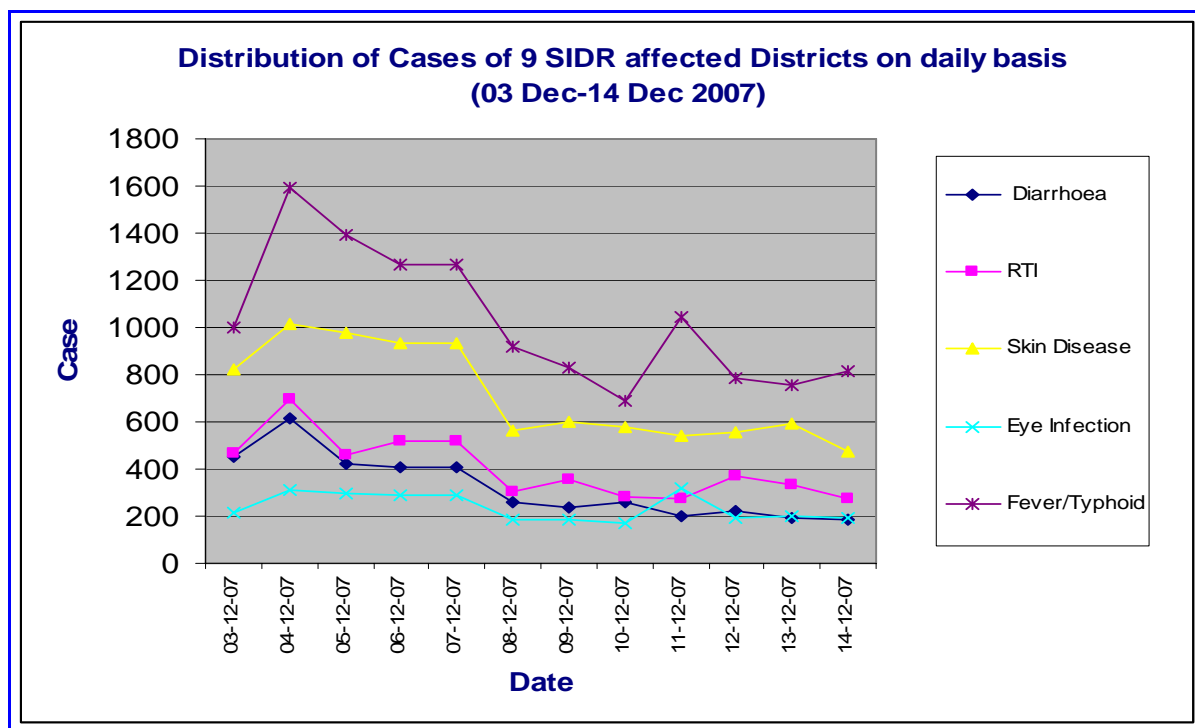

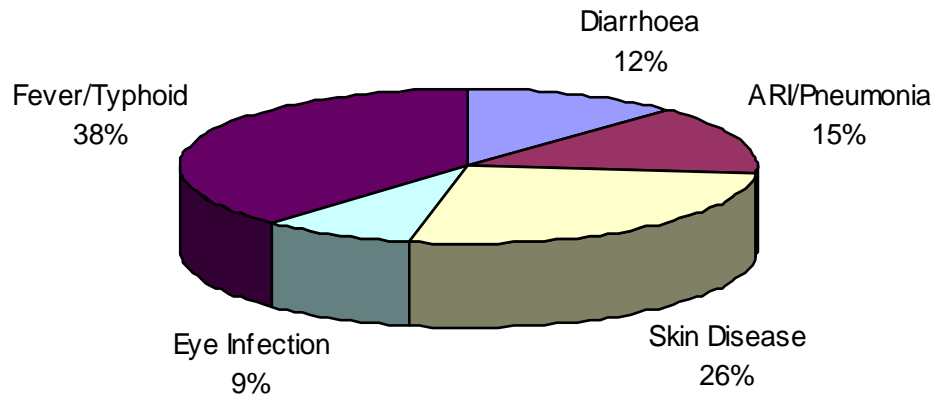

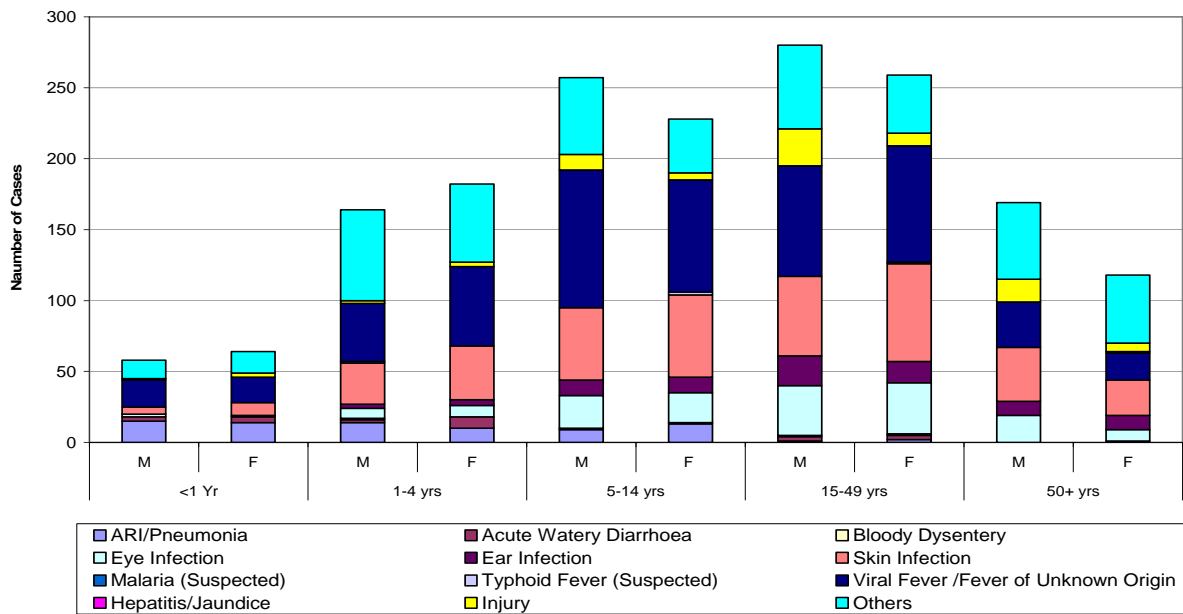

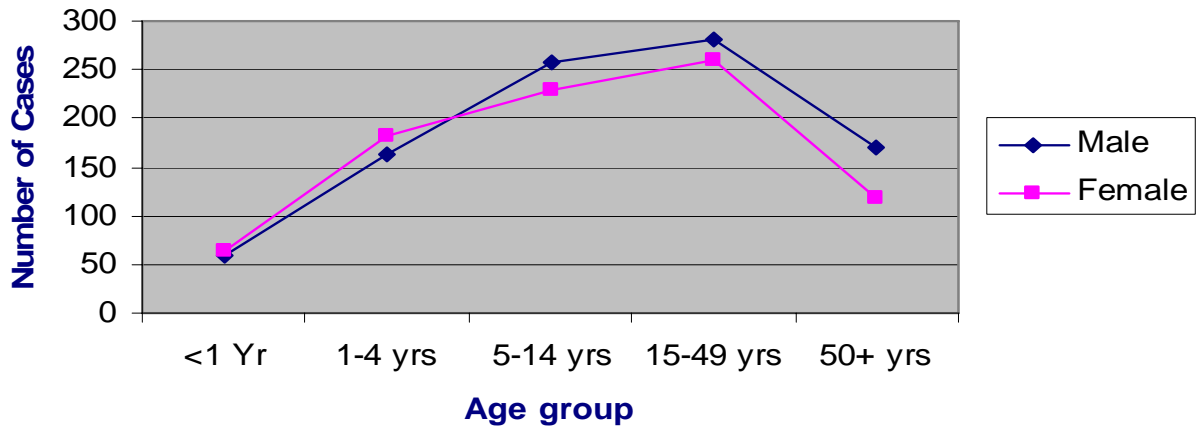
**Cummulative Cases of 9 Severely affected districts following

(03 December-14 December 2007)**



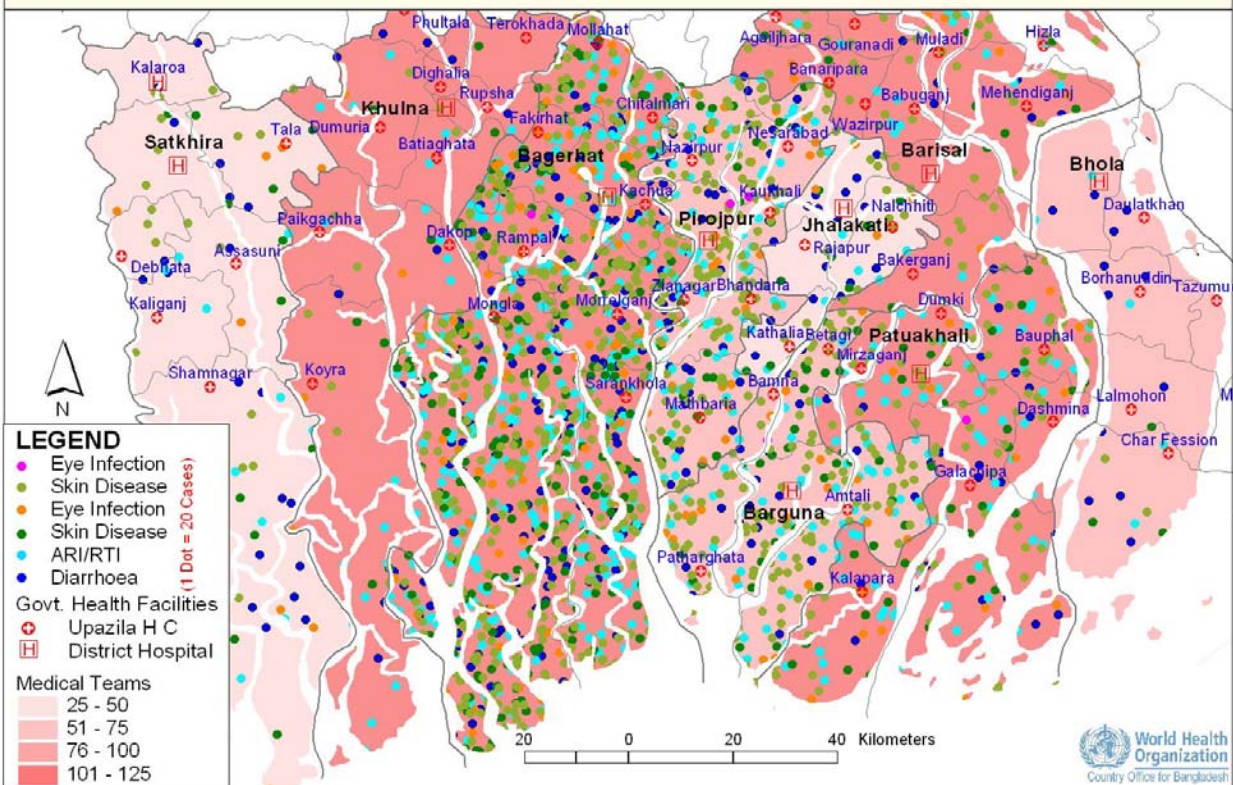
**Age and Sex wise cases
