- Bagerhat district had highest number of reported cases during last week.
- There seems to be a slow rise in disease trend.
- In Bagerhat district, 45% of the cases are within <1-14 years age group

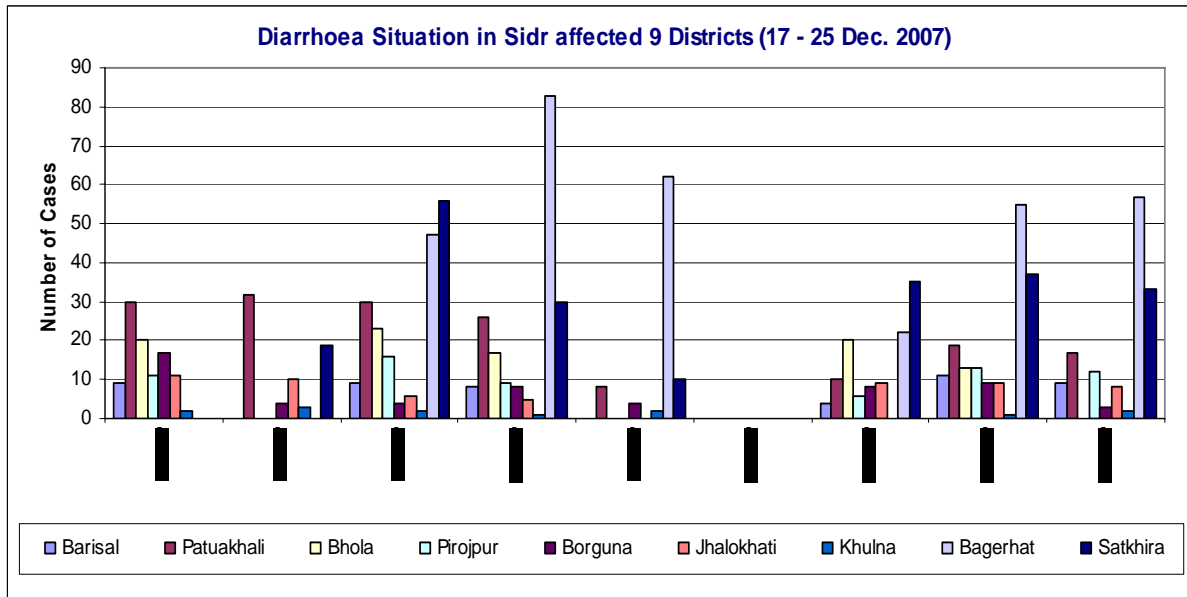
Public Health Intervention:

- The new disease surveillance form has been agreed in disease surveillance sub group and will be presented in 5th Meeting of Health Cluster, Local Consultative Group, Disaster and Emergency Response (DER) Sub-Group meeting on 27th December, 2007.
- Other Health Cluster sub-groups are to continue their work.

Challenges and Priority Action:

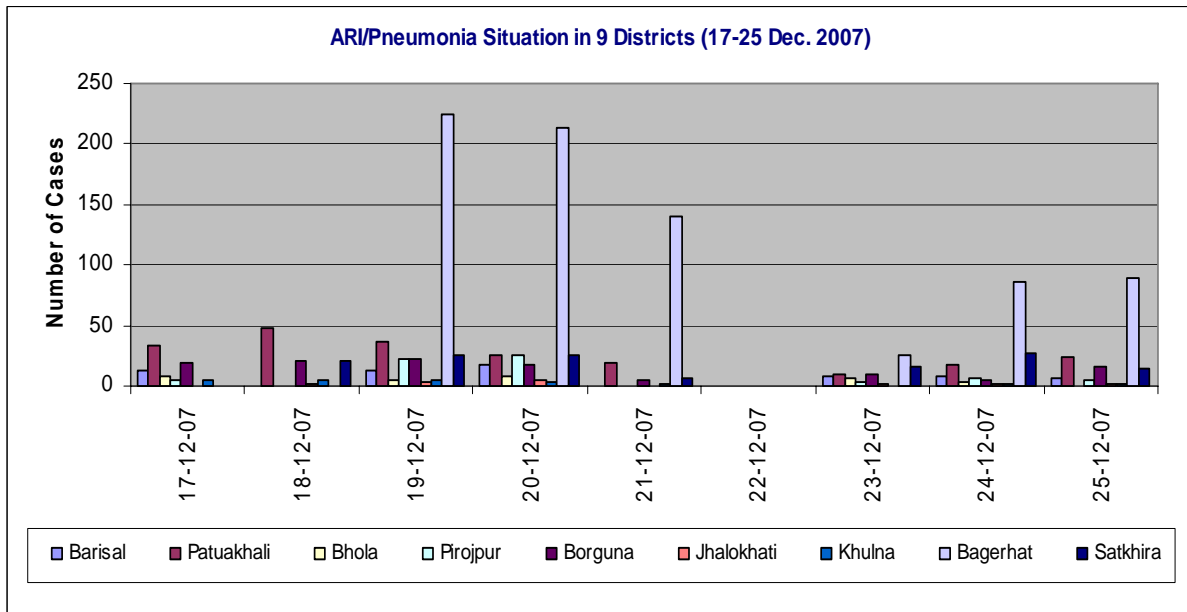
- Questionnaire and methodology for health assessment is underway and will be presented in 5th Meeting of Health Cluster on 27th December, 2007.
- A team of special technical group from IEDCR & WHO BAN has been working to provide technical assistance to MERLIN in finalizing the methodology and questionnaire.
- WHO is going to organize psycho social & mental health trainings for the physicians and community level health workers to provide psychosocial support to the SIDR victims from 7 January 2008.
- Training courses for capacity building on emergency preparedness & response for nurses will be held in 9 SIDR affected districts (hospital & upazilla level) with the technical support from WHO.

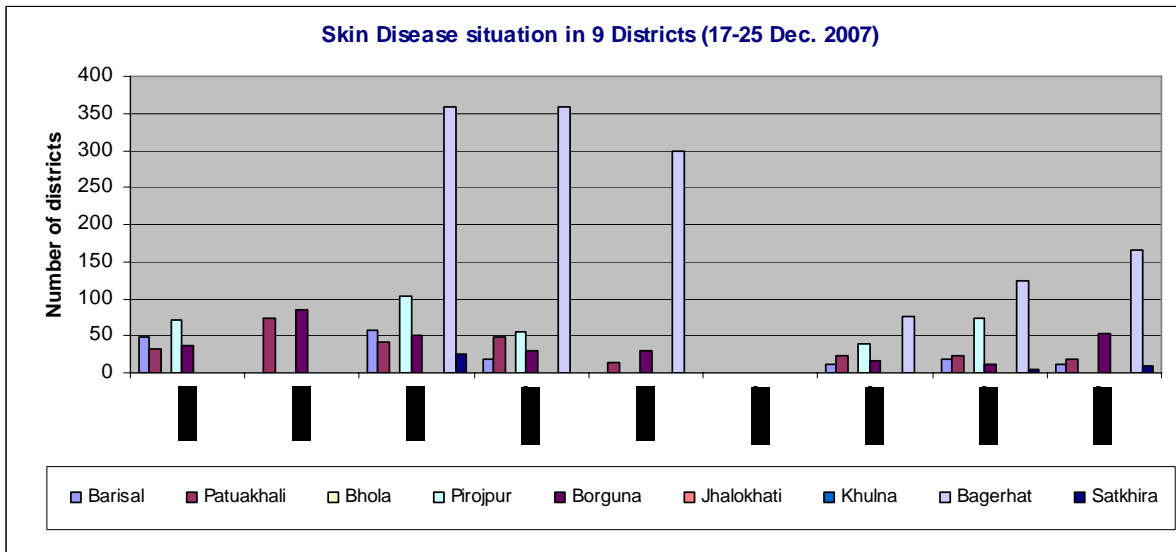

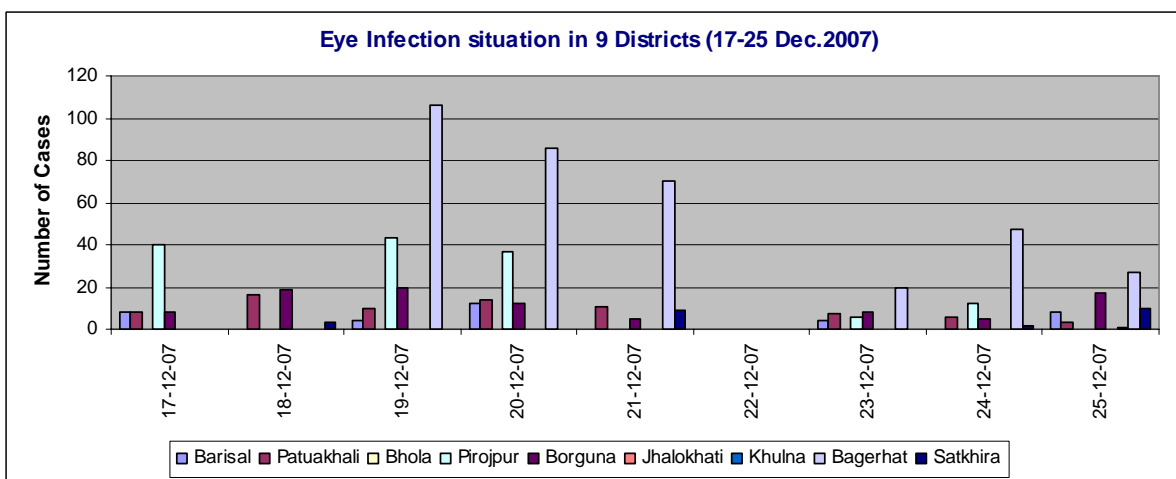

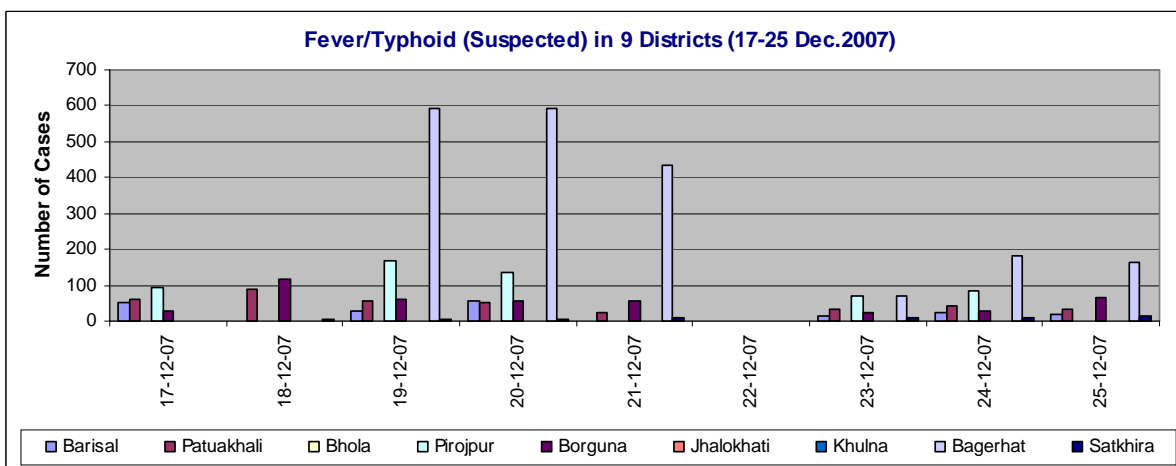

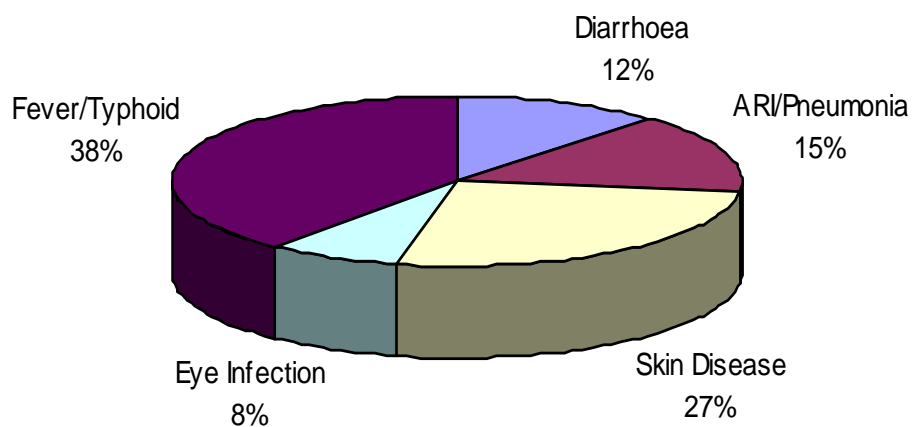

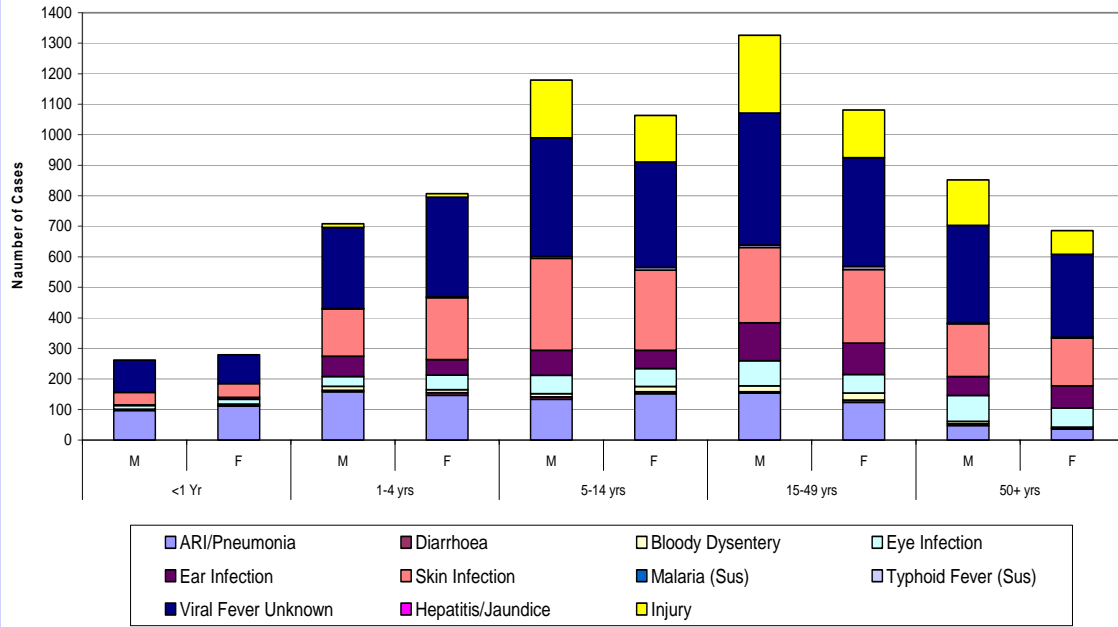

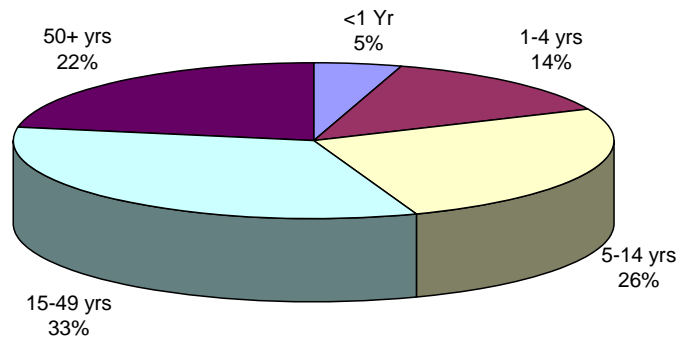
Cumulative Cases of 9 Severely affected districts following Cyclone SIDR (17 December-26 December 2007)

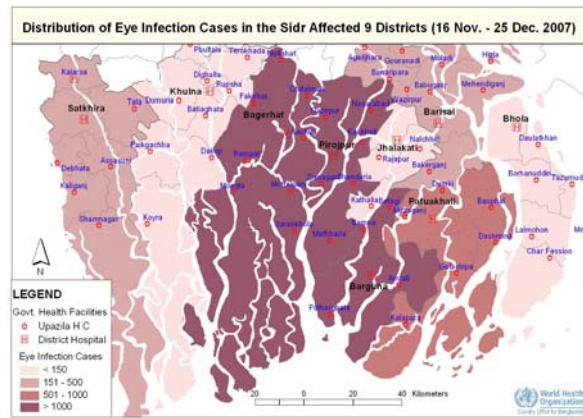
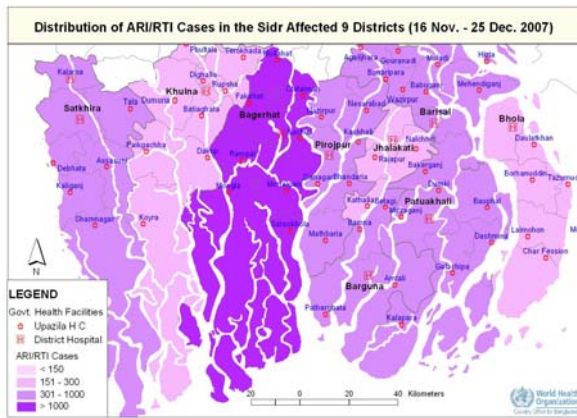
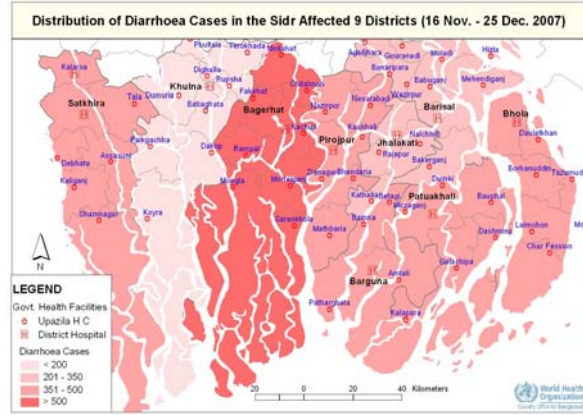
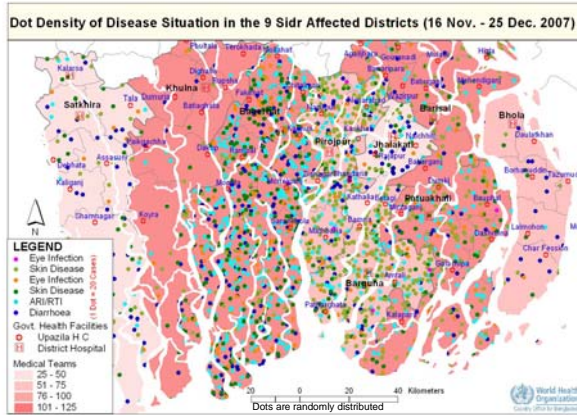


**Age and Sex wise cases
