CANDIDATES FOR EXPERTS ROSTER

The World Health Organization Regional Office for South-East Asia, New Delhi, invites applications from qualified professionals with expertise in the areas listed below for review and inclusion in its roster of experts for the **Emergency and Humanitarian Action (EHA) programme**. The objective of the programme is to reduce the health consequences of emergencies, disasters, crises and conflicts, and minimize their social and economic impact.

Areas of expertise include:-

1. Emergency preparedness and response activities related to any of the following :
 - planning and policy for preparedness, response, recovery and rehabilitation and risk reduction in the health sector; and/or
 - during response: coordination of partners, assessments, implementation of public health interventions; familiar with UN/IASC/Cluster approach methods and tools and/or
 - Managing recovery, reconstruction and mitigation activities pre or post emergency
2. Specific public health areas as applied in emergency preparedness and response settings inclusive of but not limited to the following:
 - public health planning/health system development
 - epidemiology/disease control & prevention/surveillance and response
 - water and sanitation;
 - mental and psychosocial health;
 - nutrition and food safety;
 - reproductive health;
 - child health;
3. Specialty skills in the following aspects in the emergency preparedness and response context:
 - Logistics and supplies management
 - Communication and media management
 - Information management including data analysis/GIS
 - Project management
 - Resource mobilization, partnerships, grant management, and donor coordination

Candidates with the requisite skills and experience will be included in the roster and considered for temporary assignments ranging from one to twenty-four months, either at the WHO Regional Office in New Delhi, or in any of the following country offices: Bangladesh, Bhutan, Democratic Peoples Republic of Korea, India, Indonesia, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Thailand and Timor-Leste.
