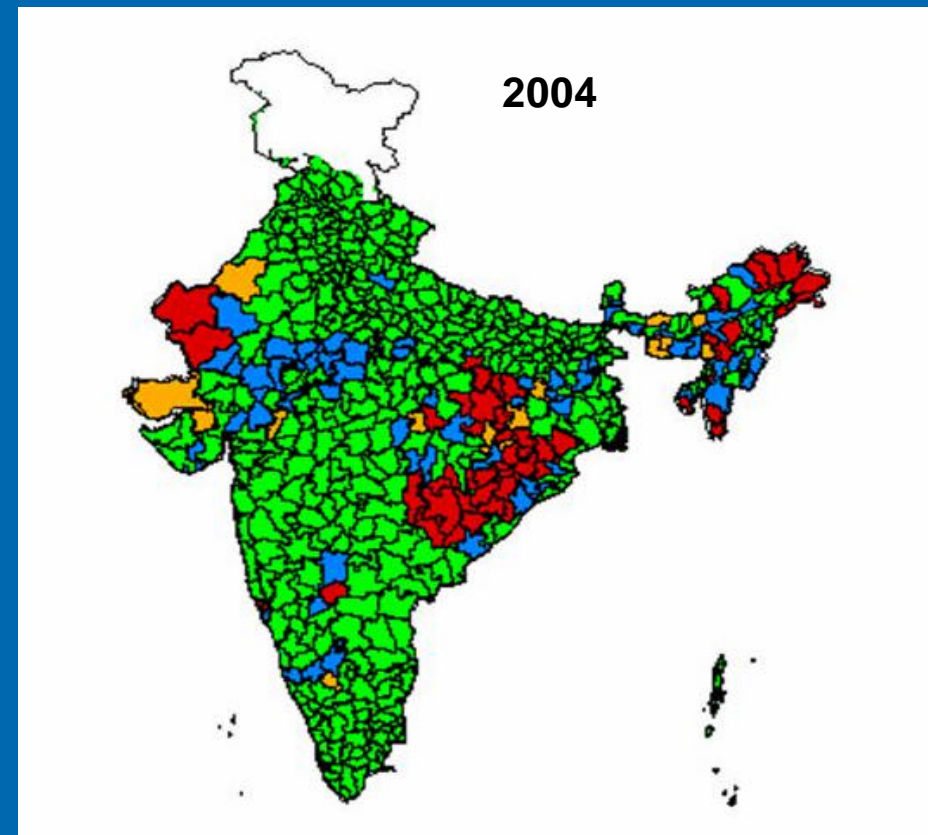
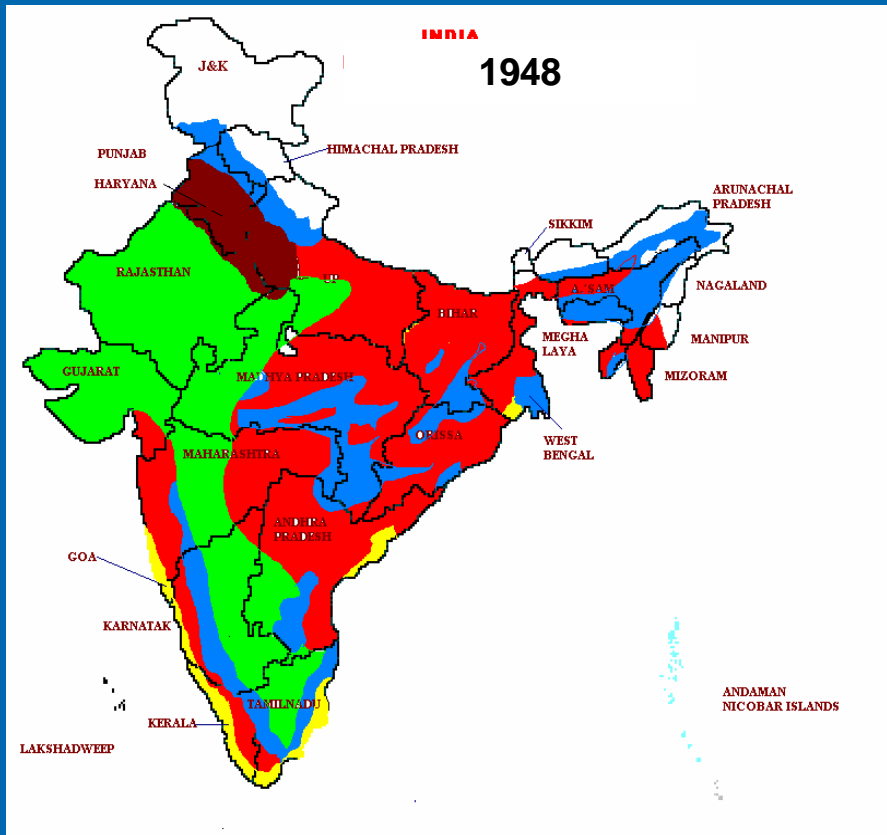








MALARIA ENDEMICITY IN INDIA



-  Areas above 5000 FT. (Non Malarious)
-  Known Healthy Plain Areas (Spleen Rates under 10%)
-  Moderate to high endemicity
-  Hyperendemic – Forest & hill tracts and terai land
-  Variable endemicity associated with dry tracts (potential epidemic areas)
-  Known areas liable to fulminant epidemic (alluvial) malaria
