

## SITUATION REPORT No. 2: 27 April 2015

---

### 1. Situation Update

- Latest reports indicate that over 3200 people have been killed and more than 7600 have been injured following the earthquake of 25 April 2015.
- The MOHP's current projections are 5000 deaths and 50 000 injured.
- Almost half of the country's districts (35 out of 75) have been affected. The worst-hit districts are Bhaktpur, Dhading, Dolkha, Gorkha, Kathmandu, Kavre, Lalitpur, Nuwakot, Ramechhap, Rasuwa and Sindupalchowk
- The Ministry of Home Affairs (MOHA) is coordinating the health response and convening regular meetings with CNDRC.
- The health cluster is meeting regularly under the auspices of the MOHA.
- Medical teams from Bangladesh, China, India, Israel, Japan, Pakistan, Qatar, Malaysia, Russia, Singapore, the United Kingdom and the United States of America have offered to deploy medical teams and surge capacity to assist with the response.
- Twelve foreign medical teams are already in the country. The MoHP has asked that additional medical teams remain on standby until it has assessed needs.

### 2. Immediate needs

- 100 medical tents, each with 50-bed capacity
- Essential medicines (see Annex 1).
- Water and sanitation services in temporary camps.

### 3. Health Sector Response

#### Ministry of Health and Population (MOHP)

- The MOHP is coordinating the health response from its Health Operations Centre, and has nominated senior directors and focal points to coordinate operations in the 11 most affected districts.
- The Executive Director of the NHRC has been given overall responsibility for coordinating foreign and national medical teams. Foreign medical teams are being deployed to affected districts outside Kathmandu Valley, in coordination with the Nepalese army.
- Health Cluster partners are meeting daily.
- The MOHP is assessing the main hospitals for structural damage.

## 5. WHO

- WHO has deployed experts from its regional and headquarters office to support the emergency response.
- WHO has released US\$ 175,000 from its South East Asia Health Emergency Fund, and has dispatched a medical tent as well as standard emergency health kits and specialized kits for diarrhoeal diseases and surgical and trauma care.
- WHO is providing close coordination support to the MOHP.
